Bill Bowlby, Al Harris and I are pleased to announce that we will once again be offering our state-of-the-art, hands-on seminar in traffic noise analysis. The seminar will be held on the campus of Vanderbilt University, and will feature extensive computer usage. Among other things, we will be using STAMINA 2.0 and OPTIMA for noise prediction, HICNOM for construction noise, and IMAGE-3 for parallel barrier analysis.

We suggest that you strongly encourage those consultants you are currently using or planning to use for noise studies to participate in this seminar, as well as members of your own staff. As you know, FHWA noise analysis training is neither routinely available nor offered to consultants, and FHWA is now charging State agencies to train their own staff. Our seminar represents one comprehensive analysis/design oriented course. It is not necessary for attendees to be experienced in noise issues.

Together, Bill, Al and I represent more than thirty years experience in state and FHWA highway-noise specialist positions, and have trained more than 400 Federal, state, local, and consultant personnel in highway traffic noise.

Attached is a brief description and agenda for the course, which has a total cost of \$595.00. Included in that cost is an extensive notebook and set of manuals.

In response to your request I have attached a list of the agencies and organizations who received noise program equipment (other than from EPA Regions) under EPA Revocable License Agreements according to copies of the Agreements in the ONAC Equipment Notebook. I have added the name of our current contact person from each State agency or organization. These are not necessarily the individuals who signed the license but program people who should know about the equipment and can respond to your request for an inventory.

I located an undated Equipment Master which appears accurate but incomplete, so I have compiled an addition to that list based on RLA information in the notebook. Copies of both are attached. If there are additional licensees not on these lists please let me know.

You are probably aware that many of those listed also have equipment loaned by EPA Regional Offices and/or purchased under EPA grants. I have had constant difficulty, while obtaining grant reports, in getting the grantees to list only grant purchased equipment. Your request will need to make clear that you want an inventory only of equipment on loan from EPA Headquarters and should not include Regional Office or grant purchased equipment.

Subject: NOISE CONTROL ASSISTANCE

When I called the EPA Office for assistance, I was told that they no longer have a noise control program. Doesn't EPA have a noise office?

The Office of Noise Abatement and Control is currently being phased-out. The Regional Noise Control Offices, such as the one in Dallas, were closed September 30, 1981. The main offices at EPA headquarters in Washington, D.C. will be closed September 30, 1982.

Who can take care of my noise complaint?

As always, the primary responsibility for the control of noise rests with the State and local governments. Federal action is necessary to deal with some major sources which are involved in commerce, and where the source requires national uniformity of standards, i.e. interstate trucks and rail carriers. It is suggested that you contact the following officials for the specified types of noise sources:

I don't have a noise complaint, I just need some information regarding sound and noise for a service club/ school project/personal use.

When the Regional Noise Office closed, the remaining pamphlets and documents were deposited in the EPA Office of Public Awareness, and distributed to State and local noise control offices throughout the Region. The EPA office in Washington, D.C. may also be of assistance.

I want to borrow a sound level meter. Does EPA still lend acoustical equipment?

No, there is no longer any noise equipment in our Dallas Office. Contact the New Mexico or Oklahoma environmental agency or the University of Texas at Dallas Regional Technical Assistance Center for details on their loan programs.

I'm concerned about the noise levels from a proposed project in my neighborhood; whom do I contact?

Contact your local planning agency. If an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) has been prepared, study the noise section and make written comments to the responsible agency.

When Ears Can Simply Stand No More

She doesn't say what tipped her over the edge. Perhaps some punkistry. Perhaps a 15-minute conga drum solo. But Veda B. Wilson of Northwest made one thing perfectly clear. She and other apartment dwellers have had it up to here with the loud music being inflicted on them by their neighbors.

"I live in a small, four-unit building [near Missouri Avenue] in a block made up of such buildings, wall against wall," Veda writes. "In the adjacent building, in the apartment which is on the other side of the wall from mine, lives a ~~person~~ who plays his music so loudly that I can not only feel the vibrations through my carpeted floor, but also can barely hear my own television in my living room

"I've lost count of the times I've gone next door to ask him to turn the music down. I've also lost count of the times that I [or my landlady, who does not live in the building] have called the police, who don't see this as a priority item, and treat it accordingly

"The police tell me that D.C. law forbids the loud playing of music between 11 p.m. and 9 a.m. Fine! But does that mean that for 14 hours of the day, a person can be deafened by another's noise? Or that one either has to live in ear plugs, or move?"

Charles Stephens, a housing inspector for the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, and Thomas Butler, the chief inspector, got on the phone simultaneously with this explanation:

If you call the police with a loud music complaint, they'll first determine if the complaint is valid, or if it's just a question of one person not liking another's taste in music.

If it is a question of excessive noise, the police will summon a housing inspector. Inspectors measure the noise with a meter. If the meter shows more than 60 decibels between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m., or more than 55 decibels between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m., the police will write the loud music fan a \$50 ticket.

If a second ticket has to be written, it will be for \$100. The third will be for \$150. After the third, the music fan will be arrested. However, Stephens and Butler say that one \$50 ticket usually straightens things out just fine.

If you want to file a noise complaint with the inspectors, call 727-7709. But Stephens and Butler advise you to call police if the incident is taking place outside of normal business hours. That way, there will be an independent witness when the inspectors enter the case the next morning.

The one thing you shouldn't do is fight fire with fire. If somebody likes loud music, he probably won't be affected if you retaliate by trying to blast him out of his socks. The cops and the inspectors are there to handle such things. Let them do what they do best.

An Inaugural story that still needs a happy ending:

John Horborsman and his wife Nancy moved here from Cleveland seven months ago. To a lot of us who've been here for centuries, the glitter and glamour of Washington are old hat. To John and Nancy, however, a chance to attend the inaugural festivities at the Kennedy Center was hardly the time for ho-hum. They accepted, with pleasure.

The evening was wonderful. John took a picture of Nancy shaking hands with Vice President Bush. John took a few snaps of President Reagan from only 10 feet away. And most incredible of all, as the couple left the KC at about 11:45, they actually found a taxi.

But that's when a nice time turned sour. John left the camera in the cab, with the irreplaceable pix still inside. Capitol Cab officials say they've queried all their drivers, with no results.

So here's one final try: If there's a Capitol Cabbie who took a couple to the 200 block of E Street NE on Inaugural Night, and who has found a Kodak pocket camera, please call me at 334-7276. I'll reunite camera (and film) with cameraman.


This communication is prompted by your letter of November 18, 1983 to Congressmen Wortley concerning environmental noise (copy enclosed).

This Department is not currently offering noise control assistance to local governments. Since the United States Environmental Protection Agency terminated funding for state and local noise control programs on October 1, 1982, it has been impossible to continue an active environmental noise control program. Trained personnel have been reassigned to other duties. The sound monitoring equipment, formally available for use by local governments, has not been calibrated for over a year, and cannot be used.

In the event of future noise pollution inquiries, the public should be encouraged to seek solutions through their local governments. Questions from Congressmen, Legislators, and other public officials should be directed to Henry G. Williams, Commissioner of Environmental Conservation, rather than individual staff members.

Your letter to the President concerning noise impact from Stapleton International Airport operations has been referred to the Environmental Protection Agency for reply.

Aviation noise regulatory authority rests with the Federal Aviation Administration, with the airport proprietor sharing responsibility for controlling noise through airport design and in scheduling and operations. EPA's former Office of Noise Abatement and Control (ONAC) in previous years had submitted regulatory proposals to FAA and also provided some planning and other assistance on airport noise to communities and citizens, both directly and through its Airport NCHQ program. ~~(Avid Record of the City of Aurora was one of the major participants in the latter program.)~~ However, ONAC was closed in September 1982 so we no longer have the capacity to furnish any direct assistance on noise ^{technical} problems.

I am aware that you and other citizens of Aurora have been working actively to solve this problem. Although you have undoubtedly already contacted both the National and Regional FAA Offices, I am forwarding a copy of your letter to their office at 800 Independence Ave. S. W., Washington, D. C. 20591 and hope they will reply directly to you on your serious concerns.
